

# Who Can Be Held Liable after an Atlanta Truck Accident?

Many people think only the driver can be held responsible for a truck accident.

However, there are a variety of parties that may be held liable, depending on the cause of the wreck.

In addition, more than one party could be held liable.

## 1. The Driver



A truck driver may have been distracted, impaired or fatigued. In some cases, the driver may have received inadequate training or loaded their trailer in a hazardous way.

## 2. The Owner



An owner could be held liable if they failed to perform routine or necessary maintenance on the truck, causing equipment failure that led to the collision.

## 3. The Leasee



If a truck is being leased from a separate company, it's the responsibility of the leasee of the truck to perform maintenance and ensure the vehicle is safe for operation.

## 4. The Manufacturer



If the truck was not constructed properly or there was a known defect that the driver or owner was not alerted to, the manufacturer may be the party responsible.
